



NGĀ AHO SHORTS 2019

Pitching for the first round of Aho Shorts will take place at the National Hui ā Tau, March 16th 2019. Venue Hollywood theatre, 20 St Georges Road, Avondale.

There is a minimum of \$10,000 available from NAW for selected short films. A shortlist will be announced on the day of the hui and a first draft of scripts will be expected by 15th April and final draft by 20 May, 2019

RULES

1. You must be a fully paid up member of Ngā Aho Whakaari or paid up and registered for the Hui ā Tau in order to be eligible to pitch.
2. To check your membership email pa@ngaahowhakaari.co.nz
3. The Producer and director of your film must be Māori.
4. Scripts in Te Reo Māori are given additional funding.
5. If selected as a finalist, the producer must demonstrate how they will raise additional funds (this is the job of a producer).
6. Pitches must be no longer than 3 minutes. All speakers will be stopped at 3 minutes.
7. You are ineligible to apply for Aho Shorts funding if you have received short film funding from Ngā Aho Whakaari in the past.
8. If you are unavailable to pitch on Saturday 16th March then you can submit a clip of your pitch which must be received by us no later than 5pm Wednesday 13th March.

This is a guide to help you with your pitch:

RULES

You are ineligible to pitch for funding if you have received funds from Ngā Aho Whakaari in this category before.
